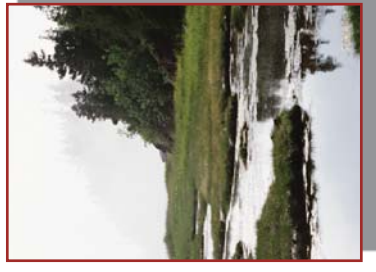
A comprehensive, technical understanding of surface water hydrology, hydrogeology, and regional water quality issues throughout California supports our compliance capabilities.

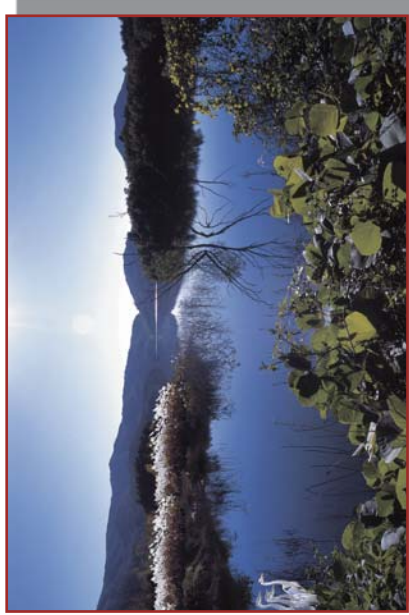

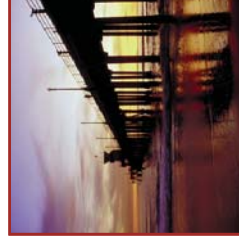
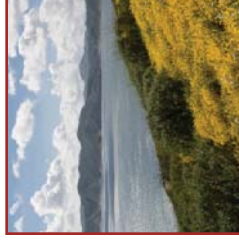
